### Spring Sailing:

Although the season got off smoothly, recently, as many of you have already found out, the Sailing Association has run into several hurdles. Presently, a major policy problem exists between the UVASA and Lake Monticello administration. Our yearly contract with the lake stipulates that we have our motor boat operating any time that a sailboat is being used. While in past years this clause has been ignored, the lake administration has made it clear that they now intend to enforce it. With this rule in effect, pleasure sailing on an individual basis will no longer be possible. This is a sacrifice we must all make until a feasible solution is worked out. In the meantime, however, and so that you may all get plenty of sailing in before the end of the semester, the following plan has been drawn up.

1. Sailing lessons will now be given on Thursday as well as Wednesday and Friday. As in the past, all rides will leave the steps of Mem Gymn at 2:30 (please bring cars!!).
2. If you plan on sailing any other day of the week, we are going to ask that you call the officer assigned to that day the night before (list below).

This plan, although inconvenient, must be put into effect so as to ensure that the motorboat will be on the lake while you are sailing. ANYONE CAUGHT BY LAKE MONTICELLO ADMINISTRATION SAILING WITHOUT THE MOTORBOAT IN OPERATION RUNS THE RISK OF BEING PROSECUTED AS A TRESPASSER AND GETTING THE UVASA KICKED OFF THE LAKE. We hope a more convenient arrangement will be worked out shortly.
