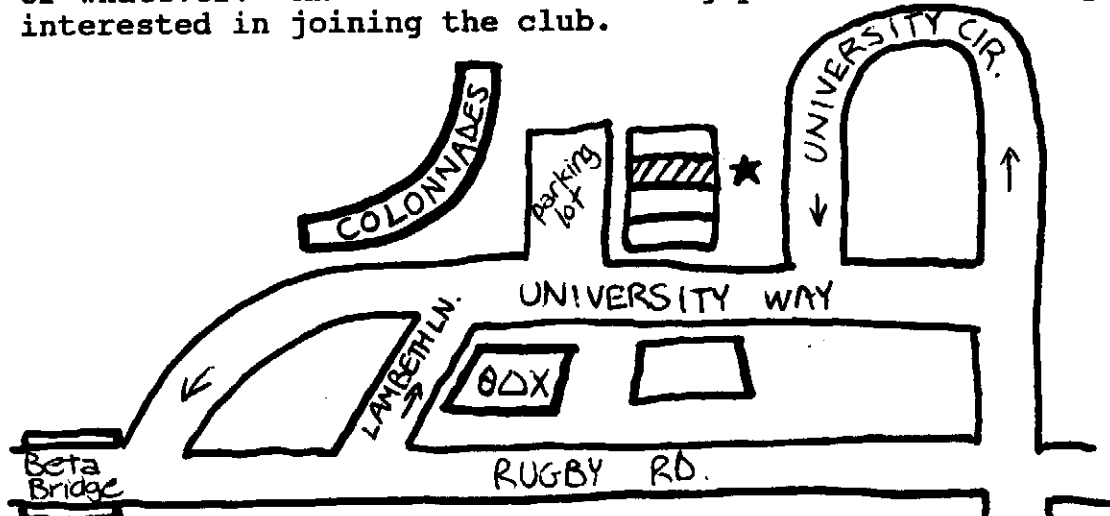


# ⚓ SAILING NEWS ⚓
